What does the story tell us about the person's house Jesus went to? What did he think of himself?

What does the story tell us about the woman who came to the dinner?

What did it mean that she had washed Jesus' feet with her tears, dried them with her hair, kissed them, and put perfume on them?

In verses 41-43 Jesus tells a story about the cancellation of debt. Why do you think Jesus told Simon this story?

So, what is this story saying to us? What is the point?

This is not a story about a woman who has less than, it is a story about a woman who has been given more than she could have ever imagined.

What is this story saying to you?

What do you think the woman did after that encounter with Jesus?

What do you feel God calling you to do today?
